Municipalities

Socio-economic and business sector

- ▶ Encourage and support students who have been hired or who are on stage, to continue their studies and to persevere
- ▶ Have a discussion with youth about their career aspirations
- ▶ Host a discussion over coffee on employee breaks (or staff meetings) and discuss perseverance and obtaining a high school diploma
- ▶ Adoption of a work-place resolution to encourage school success and perseverance
- ▶ Discuss with employees who are parents, how they can encourage their child to succeed and support school perseverance
- ▶ Staff wears school perseverance ribbons to show their support
- ▶ Implementation of a work/school support program such as “Be a link in the chain” and 6-9-15

Primary **Schools**

- ▶ Get students to find and read texts on perseverance and effort
- ▶ Get parents to come into classes to speak about their professions

- ▶ Send a letter to parents explaining school perseverance days and encourage them to become active participants in their child’s perseverance

Secondary **Schools**

- ▶ Invite guest speakers who can speak to students about a personal experience and can provide concrete examples of challenges they have faced and how they conquered them
- ▶ Take examples from the “10 factors that encourage perseverance” and carry out activities
- ▶ Celebrate students who have demonstrated perseverance
- ▶ Organize extra- curricular activities that strengthen the relationship between students and teachers
- ▶ Send a letter to parents explaining school perseverance days and encourage them to become active participants in their child’s perseverance
- ▶ Organize workshops for students where they will learn about employment opportunities and courses they can take in the future
